Please ensure that your nomination form is completed by **Friday 1 September 2023**.

The judges will review the submitted information to determine the award winner. The winners will be announced during the ceremony in Manchester on Friday 17 November. We encourage you to attend the ceremony and reserve your free place [here](#).

This award recognises community energy organisations that are proactively addressing environmental issues or contributing positively to local environments and biodiversity, and inspiring others through their activities.

In order to nominate your organisation for this award, please prepare answers and clearly demonstrate as many of the following as possible:

1. The organisation's commitment to educating both their workforce and the public on environmental issues, fostering awareness and inspiring action through innovative educational programmes, workshops, or campaigns.
2. Active efforts or programmes to increase local biodiversity or improve the physical environment.
3. Examples of, for instance, effective carbon footprint reduction measures or waste reduction.
4. Empowering individuals to make sustainable choices.
5. Sharing learning and expertise.
