Please ensure that your nomination form is completed by **Friday 1 September 2023**.

The judges will review the submitted information to determine the award winner. The winners will be announced during the ceremony in Manchester on Friday 17 November. We encourage you to attend the ceremony and reserve your free place [here](#).

The Community Engagement and Inclusion Award recognises the exceptional commitment of community energy organisations in England to build sustainable communities through inclusive, long-term, measurable, relevant, and sustainable community engagement.

In order to nominate your organisation for this award, please prepare answers and clearly demonstrate as many of the following as possible:

1. The nature of the engagement work and the thinking behind it, particularly the local understanding and strategic thinking underpinning the initiative.
2. Outreach to diverse/disadvantaged parts of communities.
3. Evidence of the impact of engagement work, e.g. numbers reached.
4. Innovative ideas and new approaches.
5. Involvement of volunteers.
6. Sharing learning and expertise.
