Please ensure that your nomination form is completed by **Friday 1 September 2023**.

The Fuel Poverty Action Award celebrates the remarkable contributions of community energy organisations in addressing the multifaceted challenges of fuel poverty and energy efficiency in England.

In order to nominate your organisation for this award, please prepare answers and clearly demonstrate as many of the following as possible:

1. How your organisation actively addresses fuel poverty and/or promotes or instals energy efficiency measures targeted at vulnerable people.
2. The improvements the work has made to the lives of people suffering from fuel poverty.
3. Any notable aspects of your work, for example new/innovative approaches, particularly hard to reach communities, or overcoming challenges with complex buildings.
4. Evidence of sharing your learning, knowledge and expertise in this area with other organisations.
