***This award celebrates the increasing amount of creative, organised and motivated young people (under 25 years old) getting involved in community energy. It recognises the outstanding work that one individual young person has done to make an impact on a community energy project, or celebrates what a community energy organisation is doing to engage young people in the sector.***

In order to nominate your organisation for this award, please prepare answers and clearly demonstrate as many of the following as possible:

1. Their commitment to engaging young people in sustainable energy and climate action.
2. Their strong commitment to the community energy movement and related activism.
3. Evidence of projects involving mentoring, training and/ or apprenticeships - providing young people the opportunity for enrichment, education and/or engagement in community energy.
4. Sharing learning and expertise.
